

## WALL FRAMES

replace damaged house frame sections with concrete block or hardwood

## WALL CLADDING

don't clad unless you have to - the less places for mud + mould, the better

## FLOORS

non resilient flooring  
polished concrete or tiles with waterproof glue + grout

warping, rot + damage

## DOORS

hollow core  
solid core

# FLOOD RESILIENT BUILDING MATERIALS

use villaboard or fibre cement sheet

gap at bottom hidden behind a high skirt  
easy to clean

villaboard or cement sheet can be packed out to match gyprock walls

some opt for a clado feature wall

## DISHWASHER

dishwasher drawers instead of full height units

## Ovens

above bench height

## BATHS

replace built ins with freestanding

## KITCHEN + BATHROOM

flood resistant cabinetry



under bench height - cabinets are removable
